Rock River Koshkonong Association Twin island Gun Club Riprap Installation Project Number – LPW-018-03

Rock River Koshkonong Association (RRKA) applied for and received a \$10K Wetland Restoration Grant for the installation of riprap along the shores of Lake Koshkonong to protect the 900 acre Mud Lake wetland from continued erosional loss. The period covered by the grant was from February 21, 2003 to June 30, 2004.

RRKA installed riprap along the shoreline of Lake Koshkonong on the property owned by Twin Island Gun Club. The property included Government Lots 6 and 7 in Section 13, T 5 N, R 13 East, Town of Sumner, Jefferson County, Wisconsin. The riprap will reduce the amount of erosion on this important shoreline stretch that separates the Mud Lake wetland complex from Lake Koshkonong. Photos 1 and 2 depict the shoreline area on October 1, 2002 and show the unprotected disposition of the shoreline at that time.

The riprap installation was performed during March 3-7, 2003 by Hausz Bros., Inc. Photos 3 and 4 depict the shoreline after riprap installation and were taken on June 25, 2003. This shoreline protection will effectively reduce and minimize further erosion of the shoreline that separates Mud Lake from Lake Koshkonong proper.

The attached Reimbursement Claim contains the Forms 8700-242 and 8700-243 along with invoice and cancelled check from Hausz Bros., Inc., the contractor that installed the riprap, and photos of the area before and after construction. The invoice and cancelled check in the amount of \$10,000 represents about 350 feet of the shoreline protection. The remainder of the riprap installation was paid for by Twin Island Gun Club. A total of about 900 feet of shoreline was protected by this project.

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
Twin Island Gun Club October 1, 2002
