Pleasant Park, Kenosha County Tributary to Lake Michigan

The effluent from the Pleasant Park wastewater treatment plant (Section 35, TIN, R22E) discharges to a small non-continuous tributary of Lake Michigan. The tributary originates in Section 35, Pleasant Prairie Township, and flows less than a mile before entering Illinois.

The land surrounding the stream has some residential development and is farmed intensively. The environment within the stream is strongly influenced by the surrounding land uses. Bank erosion and runoff contribute to the soft substrate and turbid water. The stream flows along a low gradient and would become non-continuous during periods of dry weather if not for the flow from the treatment plant.

The recreational potential of the stream is minimal.

Recommendations

The section of the tributary to the Illinois state line shall be classified as a non-continuous agricultural stream.
