INTRODUCTION

In order to determine effluent limits for a possible discharge from Kasson Cheese four tributaries to Spring Creek and one to the East River were evaluated. Mud Creek was also requested and that will be addressed in a separate report. Locations are on the attached maps.

METHODS

An on-site inspection and professional judgement were used to reach the following conclusions.

CONCLUSIONS

Numbers 1, 2, 5, and 6, are grassy swales providing farm drainage. Number 4 is a diffuse swamp drainage. None of the five discussed in this report have discerable banks or channels, nor do they provide any habitat conducive to maintaining aquatic life.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is my opinion that a discharge to any of the five would result in flooding of private property, loss of tillable cropland, and would provide no social benefits.

For these reasons it is impossible for me to provide a classification for them or to recommend a discharge to any of them.


