

WISCONSIN DNR TOKEN CREEK
DANE COUNTY

August 25, 1975

The Wisconsin DNR Fish Hatchery near the Town of Token Creek discharges to Token Creek. No low flow data is available for Token Creek. An impoundment in the town creates the Token Creek millpond just above the Hatchery. The headwaters of Token Creek for the first two miles support trout. Bass and channel catfish are found throughout the stream. About four miles below the trout ponds, Token Creek joins the Yahara River near the Cherokee Marsh.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Token Creek in its entirety should be classified as continuous fish and aquatic life.
