South Branch of the Rock River

Waupun sewage treatment plant discharges into the South Branch of the Rock River. Its fishery contains Northern Pike, Bass and minnows. It is a warm water, wide and some times shallow stream.

Recommendations

From the Waupun sewage treatment plant outfall and for the remainder of the South Branch of the Rock River, the classification should be continuous fish and aquatic life.
