Hustisford-Hubbard Sanitary District Dodge County January 18, 1978

Wildcat Creek - Length = 12.0 miles Gradient = 21.0 feet per mile

The Hustisford-Hubbard Sanitary District has proposed Wildcat Creek as a possible discharge site. Wildcat Creek originates east of Iron Ridge and flows southwesterly to join the Rock River below the dams at Hustisford Several species of the fish may enter the creek during the spring spawning run. Minnows, chubs, and sticklebacks inhabit various reaches of the stream. Wildcat Creek is subject to fluctuating flows and heavy siltation in its lower reaches.

Recommendation

From the Hustisford-Hubbard Sanitary District proposed discharge site and for the remainder of Wildcat Creek the classification should be continuous fish and aquatic life.
