Fish Creek, Wisconsin


The Peninsula State Park stabilization pond discharges to a marsh adjacent to the pond. During the survey effluent was being discharged. However, the park superintendent indicated that, in the future, the pond would be operated on a fill and draw basis. Therefore, discharge would occur only once per year.

Recommendations

The marsh should be classified as wetlands.

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

