The Waldo STP discharges to the Onion River immediately east of State Highway 57. The Q<sub>7,10</sub> of the river at Waldo is 3.8 cfs.

The four mile stretch above Waldo is designated as Class II trout waters. Downstream of the impoundment and the plant outfall the fishery consists of northern pike and panfish.

Recommendation:

Continuous, fish and aquatic life.

The unincorporated Village of Gibbsville is presently served by individual septic tanks. A proposed aerated lagoon STP would discharge to the Onion River.

The Q<sub>7,10</sub> of the Onion River at Gibbsville is 8.6 cfs. The fishery consists primarily of northern pike and panfish. Siltation from heavy pasturing is a significant problem.

Recommendation:


Continuous, fish and aquatic life.



Hingham, Sheboygan County


