SPEED LIMIT ON SUAMLCO RIVER

The Town Board of the Town of Suamico, State of Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

whereas, Section 30.77(3)(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes states, any town, village or city means, in the interest of public health, safety or welfare, adopt local regulations not contrary or inconsistent with Chapter 30 of said Statutes relative to the equipment, use or operation of boats or relative to any activity regulated by Sections 30.60 to 30.71 of said Statutes.

AND WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Suamico finds that it is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare that users of the Suamico River be protected from motorboat wakes and that the banks of the Suamico River be protected from erosion caused by such motorboat wakes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Suamico resolves as follows:

"Slow-no-wake speed" shall have the same meaning in this ordinance as that phrase has in Section 30.66(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

No person shall operate a motorboat on the Suamico River at a speed in excess of slow-no-wake speed.

Any person operating a motorboat at a speed in excess of slow-no-wake speed on the Suamico River shall be fined not less than fifteen dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and publication according to law.

If any provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, its invalidity shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and for this purpose the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
