Final Report

The 2012 Beaver Dam Lake boat Monitoring program started in May with training done by Dale Hansen. The Boat Monitors started at the boat landings on May 25, 2012 and concluded on August 24, 2012. The monitors were located at the Tourist Park, Eagle Point and Norwegian Bay boat landings. The priority for placement of Monitors was Tourist Park, Eagle Point and last was Norwegian Bay

For the 2012 Boat Monitoring season the monitors spent 838 hours at the landings, inspected 1391 boats and made contact with 2,910 citizens. There were 687 boats inspected before entering the lake and 151 boats inspected as they left the lake. There were no citations issued during the season. The City also participated in the Landing Blitz over the July 4th weekend.

I would also like to acknowledge the 4 boat monitors that represented the City for their professionalism and good public relations. In conclusion I believe the City had a very good boating season and many more people were made aware of the need to keep their boats clean.
