ORDINANCE NO. 94-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1.07(5)
AND TO CREATE SECTIONS 1.08(3) and (4) OF CHAPTER 1
LITTLE CEDAR LAKE BOATING REGULATIONS

THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE LITTLE CEDAR LAKE PROTECTION AND REHABILITATION DISTRICT ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 1.07(5) of the Little Cedar Lake Boating Regulations is amended as follows:
 - (5) DIRECTION OF TRAVEL. All meterized -craft motor boats, as defined in \$30.50(6), Stats., or personal watercraft as defined in \$30.50(9d), Stats. traveling over 15-m-p-h--or-over slow-no-wake in the traffic lane must travel in a counter-clockwise rotation.
- Section 2. The first sentence of Section 1.08(1) of the Little Cedar Lake Boating Regulations is amended as follows:
 - (1) DISTANCES. No-motorboat-shall-pass- No person shall operate a motorboat within 100 feet of a moored boat, swimmer or skin diver's marker unless existing circumstances require it.
- Section 3. Section 1.09(3) of the Little Cedar Lake Boating Regulations is renumbered 1.08(3) and amended as follows:
 - (3) WEED BED AREA. No person shall operate a motor boat, water ski, aquaplane or use personal water craft in a marked weed bed area at a speed in excess of slow no wake.
- Section 4. Section 1.08(4) of the Little Cedar Lake Boating Regulations is created as follows:
 - (4) EXHAUST/MUFFLER EQUIPMENT. No person shall operate a motor boat, including personal watercraft, unless such motor boat is equipped and maintained with a muffler and exhaust system in compliance with §30.062(2), Stats.
- Section 5. Section 1.10(1) of the Little Cedar Lake Boating Regulations is amended as follows:
 - (1) IN TRAFFIC LANE. No person shall swim in the traffic lane unless accompanied by and within fifty (50) feet of a manned boat. for-each-swimmer:
 - Section 6. Section 1.12 is repealed.
