POTATO LAKE BOATING ORDINANCE #1-2012 TOWN of RUSK RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Rusk do ordain as follows:

JUN 1 8 2012

Section I Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Potato Lake.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Rusk.

Section II Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71 are adopted by reference.

Section IV No Wake Areas

No person shall operate a boat faster than "Slow – No Wake", in the following area at a speed As defined in 30.50(12), Wisconsin Statutes 1988, as "that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control." Said "No Wake" areas are:

- (1) In the area on Potato Lake known as the "narrows".
- (2) In the area on Potato Lake in the vicinity of the CTH "D" Bridge.

This area will be indicated by buoys' placed at each end of the restricted area.

Section V Markers and Navigational Aids

Marker Buoys shall be placed in the following locations:

Section VI Posting Requirements

The Town of Rusk shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town of Rusk pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Rusk Board of Supervisors would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after posting of this notice.



CONDITION REPORT

The local conditions necessitating this regulation is that a narrow channel exits between the two main portions of Potato Lake and another channel exists under the CTH "D" bridge. Because of the lack of state regulation and because of the danger of a boating accident, with boats traveling at a high rate of speed, this channel should be a "Slow - No Wake" area. At the present time, boats travel through this channel at a high rate of speed, creating an unsafe boating environment. This Ordinance would prevent boats from traveling in the channel at a high rate of speed and would protect public rights, interests and the capability of the water resource.

If this ordinance is not adopted, the impact on public health, safety or welfare could be great, creating a condition where the prospect of a boating accident is great.
