Grand Rapids Hydroelectric Project Purple Loosestrife Surveys

In accordance with the Order Amending Approved Noxious Plants Monitoring Plans dated May 10, 1999, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPS) is required annually to submit the results of the Purple Loosestrife monitoring surveys. A Purple Loosestrife survey was conducted on August 11, 2015. No purple loosestrife was observed.

The Purple Loosestrife that was reported last year was misidentified. The 2015 survey confirmed that the colony was not Purple Loosestrife but was actually Blue Vervain (*Verbena hastate*). Appendix A includes a copy of the Purple Loosestrife report form and associated figure.

WPS provided the 2015 Purple Loosestrife survey results for the Grand Rapids Hydroelectric Project to the resource agencies on August 19, 2015. The WDNR provided a "no comment" response on December 2, 2015. Documentation of Consultation is included in Appendix A.




