
In the Noxious Plant Monitoring Plan approved on July 19, 2005 TPPC is to conduct baseline monitoring within the project boundary for purple loosestrife and Eurasian watermilfoil for five consecutive years. TPPC's operators were trained to identify purple loosestrife and Eurasian watermilfoil by Wisconsin Valley Improvement Company staff in 2007.

TPPC personnel conducted a survey from the period July 15, 2007 to August 15, 2007 of the Kings Dam Hydroelectric Project boundary. No sign of either purple loosestrife or Eurasian watermilfoil were found within the project boundary during the period of monitoring.
