Wisconsin Electric is hereby filing with the Commission one original and eight additional copies of the annual monitoring report for purple loosestrife at the Pine Project for year 2000 in compliance with order 2486-018 issued August 17, 1997.

By this letter, Wisconsin Electric is also filing a request to suspend filing annual monitoring reports with the Commission. Wisconsin Electric proposes to continue sharing these annual reports with the resource agencies. In the event that during any year of monitoring, purple loosestrife is found within the shoreline of the Pine impoundment, Wisconsin Electric will notify the Commission and resume yearly reports.

In addition to annual monitoring, Wisconsin Electric continues to post information on identifying and preventing the spread of purple loosestrife on bulletin boards at the Pine project recreation Areas 24 and 34.

Report for 2000 on Monitoring for Purple Loosestrife at the Pine Project - FERC 2486

The entire shoreline of the Pine Impoundment was visually surveyed by Wisconsin Electric Power Company scientific staff (John Hrobar and Noel Cutright) in a boat. All waters and wetlands within the project boundary and the Pine River for 0.25 mile downstream of the Pine powerhouse were surveyed, including those areas of the impoundment supporting growth of submersed aquatic plants. The survey was conducted on August, 4, 2000. NO purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*) plants were found.
