RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY SLOW-NO-WAKE ON IROGAMI LAKE

WHEREAS, due to rapidly melting snow, frozen ground, and highly saturated soil from persistent rainfall in the summer and fall of 2018; and

WHEREAS, from March 13 to 15, 2019, a dangerous spring storm system with associated heavy rainfall and damaging winds moved across the entire State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2019, an Executive Order, namely, a State of Emergency in Response to Widespread Flooding, was issued by the Governor for the State of Wisconsin.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board of the Town of Marion, Waushara County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, do hereby:

- a. Proclaim a disaster declaration of high water as existing on Irogami Lake within the Town of Marion, Waushara County, Wisconsin, producing severe shoreline erosion.
- b. Proclaim an Emergency-Slow-No-Wake is declared as existing on Irogami Lake within the Town of Marion, Waushara County, Wisconsin. The period of emergency will exist until June 28, 2019.

The Town Board, or its designated agents, has the authority to order whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare, and good order of the Town of Marion and Irogami Lake during the emergency.

This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Town Board.
