The purpose of this form is to notify DNR of initial installations, inspections and replacements of Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Signage. Types of signage include the "Prevent the Spread" sign used at boat launches, the Stop Aquatic Hitchhikers sign for stream and wetland access points and boot brush stations with AIS signage attached.

Always contact the launch owner for permission before placing new signs or boot brush stations. If the launch owner is WDNR, a Land Use Agreement is required for putting up new signage, including cleaning stations and boot brush stations.
