Dear Mr. Liebl:

We are pleased to inform you that the U.S. Board on Geographic Names, at its March 12, 2009 meeting, approved your proposal to change the name of <u>Murphy Creek</u> in the City of Madison to <u>Wingra Creek</u>. The change has been entered into the Geographic Names Information System, the nation's official geographic names repository, which is available and searchable online at http://geonames.usgs.gov. The entry reads as follows:

Wingra Creek: stream; 3.2 km (2 mi) long; in the City of Madison, heads in Lake Wingra at 43°03'28"N, 89°24'30"W, flows SE then E then NE to enter Lake Monona at Olin Park; named in association with Wingra Lake, from which the stream flows; Dane County, Wisconsin; Secs 25-27, T7N, R9E, Fourth Principal Mer.; 43°03'21"N, 89°22'39"W; USGS map - Madison West 1:24,000; Not: Murphy Creek, Murphy's Creek.
