#### PART 3. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This Urban Construction Runoff Management grant amendment extends the grant period to allow for coordination of planning and public education projects with the County.

All terms and conditions of the original grant remain in effect, unless specifically amended. Grantee's obligations for quarterly reimbursement requests and progress reports continue with the same mandatory deadlines. Grantee must continue to obtain <u>prior</u> approval of all consultant or personal-service contracts; and, reimbursement requests must be accompanied by the required payment documentation.
