Ban target practice in State managed wildlife areas. (legislation/rulemaking required)

My husband was nearly shot by a stray bullet discharged at the Green Bay West Shores Wildlife Area (GBWSWA) that entered our front yard at 824 Riverside Drive in Suamico in 2020. Audio is available. On other occasions, rapid fire weapons have been discharged. This site is located in a residential/recreational area that includes a popular boat launch. Riverside Drive borders the North edge of the GBWSWA area which also includes the Sensiba wildlife unit. Riverside Drive is a popular place for walkers, joggers, bikers, atv/utv traffic. State managed properties should not allow target practice. Target practice makes these properties unusable by non target practice users and makes the bordering areas unsafe for residents.

Do you support the Conservation Congress working with the DNR and State legislature to ban target practice in State managed wildlife areas, including the GBWSWA located in a residential area on Riverside Drive in Suamico, WI?
