Reduce Panfish Bag Limit on Wolf Lake (Fond du Lac County) to 10 Fish

Wolf Lake is a 75-acre deep lowland drainage lake in northeastern Fond du Lac County. Deep lowland lakes stratify during the summer months and have a watershed greater than four square miles. Wolf Lake has 2.3 miles of shoreline, a maximum depth of 47 feet.

In 2019, a comprehensive fishery survey was conducted on Wolf Lake using a variety of sampling methods. The bluegill relative abundance population was below average when compared to lakes with similar characteristics statewide and was lower in 2019 than in 2008. The lake has been seeing a steady decline in panfish. Bluegills, once abundant, are now rare to catch. Reducing the bag limit, should allow the lake to recover faster.

Wolf Lake currently has a daily bag limit of 25 panfish per day.

Would you support reducing the daily bag limit on panfish to 10 fish?
