Ban LiveScope and 360 degree imaging locators in Wisconsin waters

With the advancements in fishing electronics it is having an adverse effect on the state's fish populations. These types of electronics can show fish as far as 180 feet from the transducer/boat, allowing an angler to get right on top of the fish. These types of electronics allow the fisherman to see the fish, the bait, and the fish hit the bait. Granted you still have to catch the fish but it makes getting on them easy. These electronics greatly reduce fish populations which will eventually lead to reduced daily limits. Continually reducing limits could result in less people buying a fishing license.
