Citizen Resolution #350423



Require All Motorized Vehicles to adhere to Reduced Speed Restrictions on Frozen Waterways.

Currently statewide, there is minimal legislation addressing motorized vehicle use on frozen public waterways. This limits law enforcement's ability to regulate vehicular traffic on frozen public waterways in the interest of public safety. State Statute 350.10(1)(i) regulates snowmobiles in this manner. In addition, State Statute 23.33(3)(gm)(h) regulates ATV's and UTV's in this manner. This resolution would be a commonsense approach to equalize motorized vehicle requirements among users on frozen public waterways in the interest of public safety. State statutes or legislation would likely be needed so that law enforcement could address the concern.

Would you support legislation requiring that no person shall operate any motorized vehicle on the frozen surface of public waterways within 100 feet of a person not in or upon a vehicle or within 100 feet of a fishing shanty unless operated at a speed of 10 miles per hour or less?
