## Reducing the panfish daily bag limit on Wadley Lake to 10 panfish total

This citizen resolution proposes to reduce the daily bag limit to 10 panfish total on Wadley Lake. Currently, Wadley Lake has a daily bag limit of 25 panfish total. For a small lake (46 acres) with easy access and close to populated areas, the quality panfish fishery has been impacted by increasing fishing pressures. With the current regulation allowing high harvest, the quality of panfishing will be difficult to maintain. The lake has bluegill, black crappie, and yellow perch in it. However, black crappies are now rare to catch. Wadley Lake is already seeing a decline in panfish over recent years and reducing the daily bag limit would reduce the number of panfish removed from the lake. Wadley Lake Sportsman Club would like to propose changing the current 25 daily bag limit to a 10 daily bag limit. This regulation change would improve the number and size of panfish in the lake.

Would you support reducing the daily bag limit to 10 panfish total on Wadley Lake?
