Group bagging of antierless deer in farmland zones (requires legislation)

Currently it is illegal to kill game for another person except during a firearm deer season. This resolution proposes to remove the restriction on bows and crossbows for antierless deer in farmland zones where deer populations are at or above goal. However junior antierless deer harvest authorizations issued to those age 17 and under would continue to only be filled by the person to whom the authorizations are issued. All other restrictions and rules for group hunting would have to be followed.

Do you favor removing the restriction of group hunting for antierless deer with bows, or crossbows in farmland zones.
