Senior Patron License

Currently senior citizens in Wisconsin receive a fishing license for \$13 less than regular, a small game license for \$9 less and a state park sticker for \$15 less. That is a total of \$37 less for seniors. However, no reduction is given if purchasing a Patrons License. Seniors, because of their age and physical limits, are far less likely to pursue game as aggressively as when they were younger. Most just like to get out a few times for the social aspects and not the harvest of game. This doesn't seem fair.

Would you support the Conservation Congress working with the DNR and the Legislature to reduce the cost of a Senior Patron License to \$130 from the current \$165, a reduction of \$35, in order for the Seniors to receive a discount based on their age as the other cited license do.
