On September 12, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for vapor investigation activities at the site referenced above.

The Department has determined that the submitted SOW is reasonable and **approves** the additional costs, with slight modifications. This site will be deferred from the public bidding process at this time. The Department will contact you if this site will be bid in the future.

The costs that are being approved in this letter are only for the portion of site activities that can reasonably be attributed to the discharges from aboveground and underground petroleum storage tank sources that have been determined to be PECFA-eligible. These are not the only vapor investigation activities that will be required to bring this site to closure, as additional sub-slab vapor probes and laboratory analyses are required for the overall vapor characterization of petroleum and non-petroleum contamination. Additional vapor probes may be needed for the PECFA-eligible investigation, based on the results of the activities being approved herein.

The Department is approving costs for the installation and sampling of five sub-slab vapor points as requested by your consultant, The Sigma Group, Inc. (Sigma). The vapor point locations should be in the following locations, two of which are different from the locations depicted by Sigma in the attached *Figure 2 Confirmation Sample Location Map*: one probe within each of the three petroleum excavation areas where high naphthalene concentrations remain beneath the new building footprint, one probe between borings SGP-8 and SGP-102 for delineation, and one probe further west of the two western hot spots (south of SGP-22, in the location depicted by Sigma). It is anticipated that these probes will be located mainly in proposed office space locations, which are planned along the southern portion of the building, as these will be the areas with greatest risk of vapor intrusion exposure. If the proposed building layout changes, you should reevaluate the probe locations so that that the risk to these spaces is adequately evaluated. For the PECFA-eligible discharges, the laboratory must report the results for petroleum volatile organic compounds (PVOCs) and naphthalene analyses. Two rounds of vapor sampling are approved. The separate laboratory costs have been removed as the lab costs are included within Task 37, VS05. A copy of the Department worksheet for the Cost Schedule tasks is enclosed for your reference.

**Note:** A claim for PECFA reimbursement must be submitted within 180 days of incurring costs (i.e., completing a task). If a claim for costs incurred is not submitted within this deadline, the costs will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement. Be reminded that ch. NR 700 semi-annual progress reporting is required until this case is closed.

Usual and customary costs for activities included in this approval will only be reimbursed at a rate equal to or less than what is allowed on the Cost Schedule and are reimbursed based upon the Cost Schedule that is in effect at the time the activity is performed. Costs for activities not included in this approval are not reimbursable without prior Department authorization.

Regulatory Correspondence (Task 7, Activity RC05), Claim Submittal (Task 27, Activity CS05) and Standardized Invoice (Task 28, Activity SI05) costs are not included in the cap approved above. These activities will be reimbursed according to the task specifications and with proper supporting documentation submitted with the PECFA claim.

The Department considers the consultant the primary controller of costs during these activities. This approval does not guarantee eligibility of any specific costs that have been incurred or that may be incurred in the future. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs will be made by the claim reviewer when the entire claim, including all invoices and reports, is submitted for payment.
