On September 12, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above. On October 4, 2020, the costs were approved for activities that include installing, developing, surveying and sampling nine monitoring wells.

Since the October 4, 2019 approval date, the Department approved additional unanticipated drilling costs on December 12, 2019 and is also approving costs herein that were requested on December 23, 2019. The Department has determined that the submitted SOW revisions are reasonable and **approves** the additional costs.

Costs are being approved to conduct soil sampling at some of the boring locations during the installation of the monitoring well network. These costs are shifted from costs previously approved for drilling without any soil sampling. The additional effort resulted in the need for one driller to continue drilling for a second day, so a per diem cost was requested and is being approved. A copy of the Department worksheet for the Cost Schedule tasks approved on December 12, 2019 and with this request is enclosed for your reference. In addition, a worksheet for the overall costs approved for this SOW is attached, which includes all costs for the SOW approved on October 4, 2019, and revisions/adjustments approved on December 12, 2019 (in italics) and January 7, 2020 (in bold).

Usual and customary costs for activities included in this approval will only be reimbursed at a rate equal to or less than what is allowed on the Cost Schedule and are reimbursed based upon the Cost Schedule that

These activities will be reimbursed according to the task specifications and with proper supporting documentation submitted with the PECFA claim.

Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs will be made by the claim reviewer when the entire claim, including all invoices and reports, is submitted for payment.
