On May 22, 2020, Andrew James of the DNR contacted you for an update on where you are with hiring an environmental consultant. To my knowledge you have not responded to his request. He had sent you a list of consultants to choose from. On July 8, 2019, the DNR received an update from you stating that you would like to move forward with the environmental clean-up at your site this year in response to the June 10, 2019, letter you received from the DNR stating the intent to file a Notice of Contamination (deed notice) on your property at W3705 Silica Road, Town of Taycheedah, WI.

The deed notice was recorded with the Register of Deeds office on August 16, 2019. The deed notice is to notify the public and any potential buyers of the existing contamination and environmental liability associated with the property. Until it is determined that you have addressed all the obligations under Wis. Stat. § 292.11 and Wis. Admin. Code chs. NR 700 – 754, the deed notice will remain in place. Once it is deemed all the administrative and statutory obligations have been met, per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 728.11(3), the DNR shall record another deed affidavit to supersede the original deed notice stating that the contamination identified in the affidavit has been remediated or otherwise addressed to the extent practicable.

Within 45 days of receipt of this letter, please hire an environmental consultant and have them submit a site investigation work plan that meets the requirements in Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.09. Once the work plan has been received, the site investigation field work shall be initiated within 90 days of work plan submittal per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.09.
