We discussed whether the entire area of soil under the parking lot needs to be treated, or whether there is a bedrock low in ~~with~~ which the solvent accumulated. I don't know whether there is enough data to establish whether or not there is a bedrock low where the contamination pooled and I don't think that there is money available to collect more data. Mark is thinking of using permanganate for soil and GW treatment - I don't have an opinion regarding this at the current time. Mark is concerned that the walls of an excavation may collapse in a sandy environment. I referred Mark to MSA to see whether they had any problems with this during tank removal at Spellman Monument across the street.
