Dear Mr. Butz:

On October 8, 2002, the Wisconsin Department of Commerce (Commerce) received a proposal for dividing PECFA-eligible and ineligible costs. On November 19, 2002 Commerce approved a 50/50 split relating to site investigation costs but denied the 50/50 cost separation methodology regarding post-remedial groundwater monitoring and reporting.

It is understood that remedial actions will begin to treat the chlorinated solvents that have co-mingled with the petroleum products at the site. In preparation for these activities, Commerce has been contacted by your consultant and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to determine the amount of PECFA funding that will be available. In order to make this determination Commerce is requesting that you submit the following information:

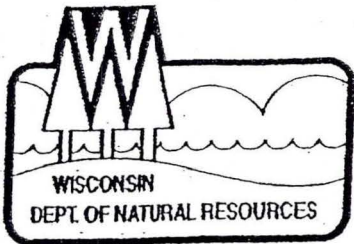
- In the November 19 2002 cost separation correspondence, Commerce requested a post-remedial contamination reduction "trigger" criteria be submitted to determine when PECFA eligible costs be terminated as well as providing a reevaluated post-remedial groundwater monitoring and reporting cost separation until the "trigger" criteria has been achieved. Therefore, please provide a "trigger" criterion and a new cost separation methodology. Please note that per Comm 47.30 (5) (b), Commerce must approve the cost separation methodology prior to PECFA claim submittal.
- In order to determine what percentage of PECFA funding can be used in conjunction with the remedial actions of the chlorinated solvents please have your consultant provide a breakdown of costs incurred to date as well as any deductibles that will be assessed upon claim submittal.
