Dear Trustee,

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is overseeing an investigation of environmental contamination in your neighborhood. The purpose of this letter is to request permission to test your business, at 224 Oak Street, City of Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, for vapor intrusion. This testing is part of an ongoing investigation and cleanup of Chlorinated Volatile Organic Compounds (CVOCs) at the former QuicFrez, historically located at 105 Oak Place, City of Fond du Lac, Wisconsin. The DNR will pay for the investigation work.

Vapor intrusion is the movement of vapors from chemicals in the soil or groundwater into the indoor air. It is very similar to the way that radon gas can move into a home or office. Not only will the results tell us if vapors are present on your property, they will also help us get a better idea as to whether vapors are a concern to the entire neighborhood. The vapor Sampling is further described in the enclosed fact sheets and we will need to coordinate a time to come into your business to install the ports and collect the samples.

The DNR received notification of a release to the environment at the former QuicFrez property in 1997. Soil and groundwater sampling identified CVOCs present in both the soil and groundwater at levels above regulatory standards. In 2010 and 2012, DNR conducted vapor sampling within a portion of the building located at 224 Oak Street, City of Fond du Lac, Wisconsin.

At this time, the DNR is requesting access to collect six air samples from the soil beneath the foundations in your business and at least one sample from the indoor air to determine whether vapors from chemicals used at QuicFrez may be present in your business and, if so, at what levels. As stated above, the DNR will pay for the cost of collecting these air samples and any subsequent mitigation needed.

In an effort to perform this investigative work within the current schedule, the DNR needs to receive your signed access agreement by January 10, 2020. Please do not modify the access agreement in any way, as it may void the agreement.
