Dear Mr. Hagedorn:

On November 2, 2011, the Department of Natural Resources reviewed your request for closure of the case described above. The Northern Region Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. After careful review of the closure request, the Committee has determined that the petroleum contamination on the site appears to have been investigated and remediated to the extent practicable under site conditions. Your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code and will be closed if the following conditions are satisfied:

The monitoring wells and soil vapor extraction system wells, air sparging wells and other remediation system wells at the site must be properly abandoned in accordance with ch. NR 141, Wis. Adm. Code. Documentation of well abandonment must be submitted to the Department on Form 3300-005, found at <a href="http://dnr.wi.gov/org/water/dwg/gw/">http://dnr.wi.gov/org/water/dwg/gw/</a> or provided by the Department of Natural Resources.

Any remaining purge water and waste generated as part of site investigation or remediation activities must be removed from the site and disposed of or treated in accordance with Department of Natural Resources' rules. Once that work is completed, please send appropriate documentation regarding the treatment or disposal of the remaining purge water and waste.

When the above conditions have been satisfied, please submit the appropriate documentation (for example, well abandonment forms, disposal receipts, copies of correspondence, etc.) to verify that applicable conditions have been met, and your case will be closed. Your site will be listed on the DNR's Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry. Information that was submitted with your closure request application will be included on the GIS Registry. Please be aware that the case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or to the environment.
