Hi Brian and Lynn,

I brought these sites to our peer review meeting. Given the difficult topography, changing lithology, probable groundwater flow in the fractured dolomite, and levels of contamination the committee recommends the following actions:

- Locate the properties on a topo map
- Map where the potable wells are in the area
- Sample all potable wells within 1200 feet of the properties
- Source removal through excavation at both properties
- At Speaker, the levels are higher and so you might consider some venting paired with the excavation
- Four quarters of GW monitoring

I would also like to see (in the closure when it comes in) the Speaker UST (and dispensers if possible) on the map like you have at Lutzen.
