Dear Mr. Meinburg:

The Department has reviewed your most recent submittal, "Results of Limited Site Investigation", dated July 23, 1998, and any additional information pertaining to this case. The Department is unable to grant closure at this time. The following are some specific comments regarding the Department's decision:

1. There was insufficient information provided to determine if an off-site source is responsible for the chlorinated groundwater and soil contamination. There is no information in any of the reports in the above mentioned site's file regarding any up-gradient/side-gradient field investigations on nor off the property near the property boundaries to prove that there is an up-gradient/side-gradient source. Also, no possible up-gradient/side-gradient source sites were located using the Department's tracking system. Your legal responsibilities are stated in a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources letter written by Michael Thompson on January 3, 1997, please see enclosure.
2. The extent of groundwater and soil contamination are not defined.

*If you have additional, relevant information which was not formerly provided to the Department, and which you feel would **significantly** impact the Department's closure decision, you may submit that information for our re-evaluation of case closure.*
