NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The Department of Natural Resources has reason to believe that Key Products, Inc. is in violation of s. 292.11(3), Wis. Stats., which requires that a person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is released take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable and minimize the harmful effects from the discharge to the air, lands, or waters of the state.

Key Products, Inc. operated a manufacturing facility on the site located at 8627-8633 W. Lynx Street in Milwaukee from 1974 –1994.

A spill was reported to the Department by Key Products in January, 1996. This spill was reported to have come from leaking containers of waste paint and solvent which had been placed in a dumpster on site. Subsequent investigation indicated that contaminants in the groundwater at monitoring well #1 exceeded the enforcement standard for tetrachloroethene, trichloroethene, vinyl chloride and cis-2,3-dischloroethene.

A closure request by Key Products was denied in a November 17, 1998, letter from the Department because the degree and extent of groundwater and soil contamination has not been defined.

Recent work was done on site from June-September, 1999, although this work was not submitted to the Department until March, 2000. We believe that, even with the additional groundwater monitoring, the degree and extent of contamination has not been defined. At least 2 additional wells will be needed to complete this definition. In addition, we do not agree with the conclusions you have drawn regarding groundwater flow direction. Groundwater flow direction needs to be better documented.
