The Remediation and Redevelopment Program (R&R) has completed the State Lead investigation at the Matthews Property, BRRTS #02-11-176566. This property is located at the corner of County Road E and Newell Road in the Town of Scott. A link to information on the property is below. Information related to the R&R 2019 investigation can be obtained through the last link dated Sept. 5, 2019. Based on the five borings and monitoring wells installed, we found no contamination that would indicate a release and, therefore, will not open a R&R case. The borings did not encounter buried waste. As you are aware, there is waste at the surface in some areas of the property.
