Based upon information collected during the Site Investigation Report dated June 28, 2019, the petroleum contamination was confirmed during site assessment activities performed in the early 1990s. Previously, the subject property was operated as a gasoline station by the current owners family (Ostrander). Upon completion of the UST removal and subsequent site assessment, the subject property is now utilized as a private residence.

On March 6, 2021, Endeavor representative (Joseph Ramcheck) conducted a telephone interview with the current property owner representative (Tracy Ostrander). Ms. Ostrander indicated that, to the best of her knowledge, the subject property never stored, used, handled or deployed perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances at the subject property.
