The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (the Department) is requesting information regarding activities associated with petroleum contamination at the site referenced above. You may be aware that as of July 2, 2013, the entire Petroleum Environmental Cleanup Fund Award (PECFA) Program, as well as regulatory oversight of low and medium risk petroleum contamination sites, was transferred to the DNR. Going forward, I will be the project manager for the regulatory oversight as well as the PECFA-funding decisions for this site. According to documents in the file, a request for case closure was submitted to the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) on November 9, 2012 by your consultant, Environmental and Development Solutions, Inc.
