

Dear Mr. Fronczak:

On March 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) sent you a letter notifying you of your legal responsibility to take action to restore the environment at the site listed above as outlined in Section 292.11(3), Wisconsin Stats., also known as the hazardous substances spill law. A copy of this letter is attached. The DNR requested that you hire an environmental consultant and submit a work plan outlining how you plan to proceed with completing the restoration of this site.

The DNR has attempted to contact you multiple times over the last two months by telephone to get an update as to how this case is progressing. To date, DNR has received no response. Therefore, the following actions will now be required.

- 1. Within the next **30 days, August 27**, you must submit written verification (such as a letter from a consultant) that you have hired an environmental consultant and have finalized an agreement to continue the environmental investigation. You or your environmental consultant may arrange to review the Department's case file by contacting David Hanson at (414) 263-8680.
- 2. Within the next **60 days**, **September 26**, your consultant must submit documentation summarizing the current status of the project and a work plan outlining the schedule for completing the investigation. The consultant must comply with the requirements in the NR 700 Wis. Adm. Code rule series and should adhere to current Department technical guidance documents.

Failure to respond to this letter will result in the initiation of formal enforcement actions against Brew City Enterprises, LLC.
