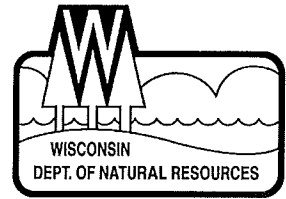

Dear Mr. Sheleski:

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) was notified on March 9, 1998 that petroleum contamination was discovered at the above-referenced location. On May 18, 1998 the DNR sent a Responsible Party (RP) letter requiring a consultant be hired and the clean-up be initiated. Since that date, the DNR has contacted you a number of times via mail and telephone.

On August 24, 2015 the DNR sent a letter to inform you of the "Important PECFA Program Changes." On September 24, 2015, the DNR sent another letter requesting a status update and that you respond within either 15 or 30 days. To date, no response has been received.

If cleanup activities have not been initiated, you must hire an environmental consultant by November 13, 2015 and have them verify to this office that they have been hired to address the contamination at the above site. By November 28, 2015, your consultant must submit an update to the DNR with documentation describing a timeline of the cleanup activities that will be completed for the above site.
