

| <b>Description of Waste:</b>                        | Low levels of Chlorinated Volatile Organic Compounds from former site use as dry cleaning facility. CVOC's in groundwater that collects in basement sump.   |
| <b>Volume of Discharge:</b>                         | Small volume / discharge related to rainfall with minimal collection otherwise.   |
| <b>Date(s) of Discharge:</b>                        | As needed during permit period. Permit may be renewed by owner sending CVOC analytical results from sump sampling one time during period of permit and fees of \$25 for permit plus \$5 for nominal discharge volume (\$30 total). <b>Owner is responsible for initiating permit renewal per stipulations stated above. Permit has been extended over multi-years due to sampling history and low level pollutants present.</b> |
