Well abandonment form says casing was cut off below surface. Can you have ~~D.M.~~ someone take a look when they're in that area?

D.L.: Flush-mount wells are often ~~difficult~~ difficult to cut off below surface w/out breaking up the surrounding concrete. Will have someone photograph the well & let you know what we find.
