As we discussed by phone, I heard from our finance staff in Madison, and the DNR will agree to remove the obstruction caused by an abandoned monitoring well casing which has heaved above the sidewalk surface near the former Hustler Hardware property. Because a portion of the sidewalk slab is also cracked around the well boring, DNR will agree to remove and repair that portion of the concrete slab which is broken. Please obtain and forward an itemized quote from a concrete contractor for cutting, removal, and repair of the cracked portion of the slab, to include cutting off the monitoring well casing to a depth which will prevent further heaving of the remnant casing through the new concrete.

If the village would prefer to have the entire slab replaced, please have the contractor cost that out, as well. DNR can only cover costs for the portion of the slab which is cracked and in need of repair. Replacement of the entire slab would be considered "improvement," the cost of which is not allowable. You may return the quote to me by email reply or via regular mail at the address below. Thank you for alerting me to the need for this work.
