SUBJECT: Conditions for closure of Arlene's Inn, N 8631 CTH G, Willard, Wisconsin. BRRTS#03-10-196577.

Dear Mr. Eagan:

I presented the Arlene's Inn case file, referenced above, to the West-Central Region Closure Committee on June 12, 2008. Based on the information provided, they concurred with my recommendation that no further action with regards to petroleum release is necessary. However, they felt that before case closure can be completely obtained, a replacement well needs to be provided for the Tieman's residence, which neighbor's your property. This well has benzene concentrations greater than the NR 140 enforcement standard.

I have been in contact with your environmental consultant, Ken Shimko of Meridian Environmental Consulting, LLC, to gather more information out about the status of the Tieman potable well. Once we get more information on this well, we can decide how best to proceed with the replacement of this well.

As we are not requiring any further groundwater monitoring at this site, you may authorized your environmental consultant to start abandonment of the monitoring wells and piezometers installed during this environmental investigation in compliance with NR 141. Then once the Tieman's potable well is replaced, this site will be eligible for closure.
