Lost about 3000 gallons of gasoline. They have installed monitoring wells, soil boring + soil pits to define the extent of the plume. They have proposed to install a vacuum extraction system to remove vapors + free product. DNR indicated that dissolved hydrocarbon contamination of groundwater must be addressed eventually. They will submit plans for the installation of the vacuum extraction system.
