Chris, not sure if you are managing this one after Ralph left but attached are the SSVS & GW results from the 3/21/19 sampling event.

The SSVS results showed no exceedences of the VAL's for the source property building (2 sample locations) and the neighboring daycare building (1 sample location).

The groundwater results appear to be at least stable to even decreasing. Please note that we could not locate monitoring wells MW-4 & MW-9 (both have been historically clean) as they were under 2-7 feet of snow. Monitoring well MW-7 (clean the two previous rounds) appears to have been destroyed (likely hit with snow plow) and the on-site private well could not be sampled as the electricity has been shut off to the building.

Based on these results, can we go ahead and proceed with the closure request which we have costs approved for? Thanks,
