We have been informed by the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources that PECFA funds are unavailable for PECFA payments. Even though the new state budget may include future funding, current invoices will not be paid until after July 1, 2017.

In accordance with Section IV of our Agreement to Perform Petroleum Contamination Assessment and Remediation Task(s) dated December 22, 2015, we have determined this is a changed condition and therefore cannot continue with the terms of our contract. We are therefore providing notice that we will be terminating our contract for the D\&G Mobil Quikmart site, located at 125 North US Highway 141 in Coleman, Wisconsin effective immediately.

We realize that you may continue to work with another consultant pertaining to this site. We will cooperate in any way we can to assist with the transition, including providing any information we have and/or answering any questions that may arise.
