To abandon the 4 in well at an estimated depth of 55 ft

We will use chips because we will be able to remove the jet pump, tremie pressure grout is only needed when

something is stuck in the well.

55 ft of chips - approximately 8 bags

Remove all pump and pressure tank equipment

(we cannot remove wiring from the panel this will require an electrician) we will cap wires

Clean up and patch floor

Estimated cost of \$750.00 for complete job

Abandonment report is included in all abandonments per state code

Brent/Chris.

Can you email me a cost to abandon the residential well at 14789 Hwy. 73 in Jump River (where you installed new well in August).

The well is an estimated 55 ft deep (depth we were able to put "wire snake" down)....might be deeper? The well casing is 4-inch diameter. The well is located inside the house (behind the pressure tank in attached picture).

Work would include:

- Remove/dispose existing pump, piping, and any associated wiring/hardware
- Abandon well consistent with State Code NR141 (chips? Tremie-grout?...please describe abandonment method)
- Cut well casing flush with floor and cement-patch floor to match existing floor
- Cleanup
- File necessary paperwork with State; provide to Meridian
- Work to be coordinated with Meridian
