- A notification for GW contamination should be sent to 14767 Hwy 73 (MW-6). You will probably need a cost request and I can place a note in Tracker
- The GW plume should be drawn to include Keeper's and the Convenience Store
- At least one figure should show that Keeper's is a shared well
- Please explain the hydrologic conditions. Why does GW flow east and west? The concern here is why does the plume impact Keepers and the Convenience Store? I have attached David Swimm's maps/notes for you review
